Why attend?

The **Introduction to Linux for QSS/OASIS** covers:

- How to log in to Linux and access system information
- A review of the QSS/OASIS directory structure
- How to manage QSS/OASIS processes, including starting and stopping QCC servers and the QSS/OASIS job server
- How to run programs
- How to edit files
- How to inspect the Linux equivalent of job \$STDLISTS
- A review of production processes (such as printing Accounts Payable and Payroll checks)
- How to manage nightly processes, such as ACTKLD, BALFIX and VENKLD
- A review of QSS/OASIS automated tasks (dealing with \$STDLISTS, log files, etc.)
- How to install QSS/OASIS Version "L" releases
